We hope that you have all had a lovely Easter break and are ready to start the final term in Nursery! This newsletter will explain the topic that we will be exploring in Nursery this term, and how you may be able to support your child's learning.

Throughout this term we will be learning about water in our world. We are going to be completing a range of fun activities both inside and outside of the classroom which are outlined below.

Theme: Water in our World.

We are going to immerse the children in all aspects surrounding water! We will specifically be focusing on 6 different themes:

- Growth and Plants- We will be learning about what plants need to grow. We will be investigating flowers and looking at their similarities and differences. We will also be exploring soil, sorting seeds and using our ICT skills to create a garden on the smart board.
- Frogs and Pond Life- We will be exploring the life cycle of a frog and looking at their habitat. We will take a trip to the pond and use nets to see what we can find in the water.
- Our Local Area and The Canal. We will be taking part in minibeast yoga, looking through fact books and identifying different minibeasts.
- Boats and Pirates- We will be looking at the book Pirates love underpants, exploring e-books. We will use our imagination to sail away on a pirate ship. We will learn about seal six, and count his treasure.
- Under the Sea- We will explore different sea creatures and look closely at their features. We will play fish parachute games, create our own fish and talk about the seal sanctuary who we will be raising money for as a part of our learning outcome.
- Beach Life- We will be exploring holidays and the beach. We will be making different types of food that you would find at the beach and creating props for our learning outcome: Bilston by the Sea fun day.
