



How do you carnival like a Brazilian?



Welcome to the Summer Term!

Topic:

Year 3 will be studying the geography of Brazil and the culture surrounding their Carnivals. Children will use resources to locate places of interest and identify human and physical geographical features.

Science:

In science we are studying plants and how they reproduce and grow healthily. Children will conduct investigations to find how plants transport water around their structures and how they use sunlight to produce their own food sources through photosynthesis.

Creative:

Children will be looking at the work of famous Brazilian artists and recreating their work through a range of media. In PE children will enjoy gymnastics and will develop sequences including the use of apparatus. In Computing, children will create a podcast about life in Brazil, including sounds/music to represent objects or create moods, using effective expression and volume.

RE:

In RE we will look further into the Hindu and Sikh faiths and explore how their followers show commitment to God in their everyday lives and how these actions make children of faith feel a sense of belonging and closer to God.

How you can help:

Please hear your child read their reading book at least once a week and sign their reading record. Please practise the weekly spellings with your child.

Please ensure your child has their full PE kit (green shorts, white top and black pumps) in school every day. If there are any problems please don't hesitate to ask.
