Science

Children will understand the importance of light including how it travels, how it affects us and how shadows are formed. Children will also research and investigate about Isaac Newton and what he discovered about colour.

History

Children will research the changes in transport, important inventions to develop transport methods and important people in history who have created our transport systems.

RE

Children will be able to answer the question, is anything ever eternal? Children will look at the Christian beliefs behind eternity and learn to understand how Jesus portrayed eternal love. Children will also look at how the belief in life after death affects a Christian's life and learn how to understand the Christian belief in 'love thy neighbour.'

Art

Children will develop their art techniques, including their control and creativity.
