You can help by:

Hearing your child read regularly and signing their record book to confirm the book has been read at home. Stickers and a weekly prize draw are rewards given for reading records being signed! However, if the reading record is not signed for two consecutive weeks, your child will have to miss a playtime.

Help with the new homework tasks, where your child can choose which piece of homework to finish and when (see Homework Sheet).

Encourage your child to learn their weekly spellings.

Encourage your child to locate and find information about their topic work.

Objectives will include:

To learn about why natural disasters occur and how they impact on peoples' lives around the world. Our key question is: "Is Our World Falling Apart?"

To learn how to locate human and physical features on a range of maps and globes.

To learn how to produce a digital magazine.

To learn about how different faiths in our community worship, including Islam.

To learn about our circulatory system – what it looks like and what it does; to learn about the heart - what is it and what does it do; to learn about the blood – what it is and why it is needed; to learn about water in our bodies – why we need water and what happens to water in our bodies.
