Topic: Natural Disasters

Science: Life processes, materials and their

properties. **RE:** Islam

ICT: Animation

Objectives will include:

To learn about why natural disasters occur and how they impact on peoples' lives around the world.

To learn how to locate human and physical features on a range of maps and globes.

To learn how to produce animations using a variety of software.

To learn about how different faiths in our community worship, including Islam.

To learn about life processes in plants and animals, looking at plants and animals in their habitat and to understand that food chains & webs can be used to represent feeding relationships in a habitat.

To recognise the differences between solids, liquids and gases, as well as the differences between reversible and non-reversible changes.

To recognise the different ways of separating solids and to gain an understanding of the water cycle.

You can help by:

<u>Hear</u> your child read regularly and sign their record book to confirm the book has been read at home. Stickers and a weekly prize draw are rewards given for reading records being signed! However, if the reading record is not signed for two consecutive weeks, your child will have to miss a playtime.

<u>Help</u> with the weekly homework tasks, which will be given to support the work being covered in English and Mathematics.

Encourage your child to learn their weekly spellings.

Encourage your child to locate and find information about their topic work.

<u>Make sure</u> your child has their named, school PE kit in school every Monday and Friday (shorts, white T-shirt and black pumps have to be worn). Sensible trainers will be allowed for outdoor sessions.

<u>Make sure</u> your child brings in their library book each Friday to avoid it becoming overdue. Children will not be able to take books from the library if they fail to return them.,
