Topic - Our topic this term is Invaders. Subject areas have links to the topic about

why people invade and what is the impact of this invasion.

History: Anglo Saxons / Vikings / Normans **Science**: Earth, Sun and Moon, Keeping Healthy

RE: Hinduism Prayer and Worship
ICT: Digital Artist/ Digital Programmer

Activities will include learning about:

- What caused the various people studied Anglo Saxon / Vikings / Normans, to invade Britain; how to use sources of evidence to think about the impact of invasion.
- Creating digital artwork which employs a variety of tools and styles; how to design programs or games in response to a given problem or challenge.
- How the Earth, Sun and Moon are spherical and support this with evidence.
- The rotation of the earth and how this affects shadows; recognising that it is daylight in the part of the earth facing the sun and that the moon orbits the earth.
- Diet and health; what the digestive system does; the skeleton and muscles as well as the heart and how it acts as a pump.
- Understanding how Hindus show their commitment to God. Looking at Hindu artefacts. How Hindus worship and show devotion to the gods and goddesses.

You can help by:

- Hearing your child read regularly and signing their record book to confirm the book has been read at home.
- Helping with the weekly homework tasks, which will be given to support the work being covered in English and Mathematics.
- Learning times tables the new curriculum expectation is that all children know their times tables up to 12×12 by the end of Year 4.
- Encouraging your child to learn their weekly spellings.
- Encouraging your child to locate and find information about their topic work.
- Please make sure your child has their named PE kit in school and it remains in school. (Shorts, T-shirt and pumps).
