Year 2 Topic Letter



This letter explains what your child will be learning about during this term and how you may be able to help. Topics taught in year 2 are planned to meet the subject guidance of the National Curriculum.

Activities specific to our topic will include:

- Topic Various History and Geography skills will be covered throughout these lessons. This term we are focusing on London's Burning—The children will be learning about this famous event through History lessons and the impact it had. Next half term we will focus on Pioneers. The children will gain an understanding that people in the past, with pioneering ideas, inventions and reforms, have had an impact on the world we live in today.
- Art and Design— Throughout the lessons the children will cover various skills such as identifying the primary and secondary colours, develop and adapt a design and evaluate their own work to identify their strengths and weaknesses.
- R.E—During R.E the children will become familiar with Islam. They will explore the Islamic faith, looking at the five pillars of Islam and their commitment to God.
- Science The children will focus on two topics during this term—'Health and growth' and 'Plants and animals in the local environment'. They will develop an understanding of the changes to humans as they grow and ways to stay healthy as well as investigating plants and animals in our local area. They will learn to use scientific language and carry out investigations.
