



ANCIENT EGYPT

Who was the boy king?

This term we will be exploring the culture and history of the Ancient Egyptians. Each week the children will be researching to discover what life was like in Ancient Egypt. Children will be presenting their findings by producing a webpage. During the topic the children will aim to answer the question, 'Who was the boy king?'

In science children will be studying animals (including humans) and looking at skeletons, muscles and how to keep healthy by eating a balanced diet.

Later in the term, we will be studying magnetism and springs. They will be looking at the forces involved, and learning to use the correct scientific vocabulary of forces, motion and magnetism. They will be developing their scientific skills by designing and carrying out investigations to answer questions such as 'which magnet is the strongest?'

In Art and Design, the skills being taught include; creating skylines of Ancient Egypt using watercolour and digital software, using clay to recreate an ancient artefact, relief printing to explore hieroglyphs and sketching techniques to depict gods and goddesses. In Design Technology, we will look at the mechanism of and create a working structure of an Ancient Egyptian Shaduf (technology created to lever water from The River Nile.)

In R.E, the children will be considering Jesus' miracles, we will be learning to retell Bible stories when miracles took place and question whether Jesus really did perform miracles.
