### Transport through the ages



**Objectives will include:**

- To ask the question - "Are we going back to the future?" as a basis for exploring transport. This will involve preparing an outcome to deliver information all about aspects of how transport has changed over the centuries and Britain's impact on transport development. Pupils will research the changes in transport, important inventions to develop transport methods and important people in history who have created our transport systems.
- To learn how to use the internet to find information quickly and efficiently on a variety of topics and research questions.
- To explore how light travels, light sources, how light reflects, shadows.
- To learn the belief systems of the Christian religion and to compare these with other religious belief systems.
- To celebrate Easter, as well as exploring the issues lying behind the Easter Story.
- To learn in ICT how to design and build a side-scrolling game.

**You can help by:**

Hear your child read regularly and sign their record book to confirm the book has been read at home.

Use any online revision guides such as BBC Bitesize to help with SATs.

Help with the homework tasks, which will be given to support the work being covered in English and Mathematics. Please help with the extra homework that your child will have, to help prepare for the SATs e.g. maths problems, Online revision, using revision guides

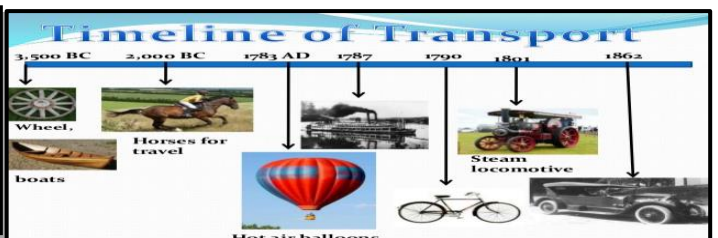
Encourage your child to learn their weekly spellings.
