Welcome back to Year 1!

This term we will be making a whistle stop tour around the world, learning the names of oceans, continents and countries before we land in the UK. Children will then visit each country of the UK to learn about their geographical features. We will be visiting parts of the local area to see how they have changed over time. We will also look at local figures from the past.

Science: This term children will be learning about the plants and trees we find in our local area, naming their features, planting and investigating what plants need to grow. Children will also learn about the changes that happen during winter.

RE: Children will learn, through the stories of Jesus, what makes a good friend and will learn the Easter story.

Creative: In music children will be learning to play the glockenspiel. In art children will be creating flags to represent the area and landscapes of the local area. In DT, children will create a fruit salad. In computing they will look at data inputting and coding.
