Welcome to Wilkinson Terrific for Twos. This booklet provides you with some information and a guide to our expectations at Wilkinson Primary School.

Our Expectations

Although the children in Terrific for Twos are still very young, we still expect them to behave appropriately and to be polite.

With support, we expect the children to:

- Say “please” and “thank you”
- Wear school uniform everyday
- Take care of the toys and tidy away at the end of the session
 - Share the toys and take turns
 - Have kind hands
- Use quiet voices when required

Our school motto is: “Show Pride and Respect in all that we do!”



Please ensure that you complete all paperwork provided. Also, please update us immediately if there are any changes to the information you have provided us for your child.



Health and Self-Care

Whilst your child is at Terrific for Twos, we encourage them to develop their self-confidence and independence.

During the session, your child will receive a piece of fruit/vegetable and the choice of milk or water during snack time.

Potty Training

We understand that every child is different and they will be able to use the potty/toilet when they are physically ready and when they want to be dry and clean.

It is important to stay consistent when potty training your child therefore we will work alongside parents/carers to encourage this as much as possible.

If you would like any advice, please feel free to ask a member of staff.



Key Person Groups

Your child will be in either Butterflies, Bumblebees or Ladybirds group and will be supported by their “key person”.

Your child’s key person will be responsible for developing a trusting and caring relationship with you and your child.

Attendance and Parental Involvement

It is important that your child attends Terrific for Twos every day.

If your child is unwell and cannot attend Terrific for Twos, please contact school to let us know as soon as possible.

Children will be collected and dismissed from the Terrific for Twos door at the beginning and end of each session.

Arriving late for the session can be very upsetting and disruptive for your child, so please ensure that you arrive on time each day.

If someone other than yourself is collecting your child, please inform a member of staff or contact the office.

We will not allow your child to leave with anyone unless previously arranged.

We will hold a range of parent workshops throughout the year which you will be invited to and also hold termly parents’ evenings.



Daily Timetable

Please see below a typical day in Terrific for Twos. The children explore a range of activities inside/outside the Terrific for Twos building. They will also visit the main school to explore the library, hall and kitchen.

Uniform

Boys: grey shorts, white shirt, green jumper, grey/black socks, black shoes and a school tie.

Girls: grey skirt or pinafore dress, white shirt, green cardigan or jumper, grey/white/black socks or grey/black/green tights, black shoes and a school tie.

Your child will be provided with a school tie and green book bag on their first day.

Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof coat each day as they will be learning in the outdoor environment.

Please also be aware that messy activities may result in some soiling of clothes, this is the nature of Early Years learning.

Please ensure that all uniform and coats are clearly named, thank you.
