## Children's Key Person Groups:

- The Nursery children will all be separated into 3 groups with their key person:
  - Butterflies
  - Ladybirds
  - Bumblebees
- Each group will have a key person who will be responsible for developing a trusting and caring relationship with you and your child.

## Uniform:

- Boys: grey shorts, white shirt, green jumper, grey/black socks, black shoes, and a school tie.
- Girls: grey skirt or pinafore dress, white shirt, green cardigan or jumper, grey/white/black socks or grey/black/green tights, black shoes and a school tie.
- PE Kits: green shorts, white short sleeved top, black pumps.
- **Please ensure all uniform is clearly named.**



## Independence:

- It is important for the children to enter Nursery in September able to complete simple tasks independently, such as:
  - using the toilet
  - washing their hands
  - putting their coat on
  - eating and drinking
- Your child's key person will be there to support your children with these tasks however if your child can already do these it will aid their transition.



- Please provide your child with a change of uniform in case of an accident at school.
- Please encourage your child to be independent when changing at home, in preparation for PE.
- Ensure your child has their green bag in school everyday with their reading books and busy work.



## Expectations of Behaviour:

- High expectations of behaviour across school.
- Rewards: verbal praise, stickers, house points, Golden Apples and certificates.
- Behaviour chart: all children start on the green apple each day and can be moved on the chart dependent on their behaviour throughout the session.



## Attendance and Parental Involvement:

- It is important that your child attends Nursery every day.
- If your child is unwell or cannot attend Nursery please contact school as early as possible to let us know.
- In the early years, parental involvement has a significant impact on children's cognitive development and literacy and number skills.
