“Well done, Sophie,” says the teacher.



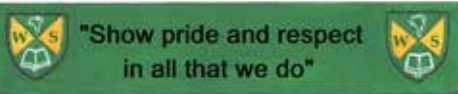

There are lots of exciting activities to do in Terrific for Twos! Inside, outside and over in the main school. Our school motto is 'Show pride and respect in all that we do'.



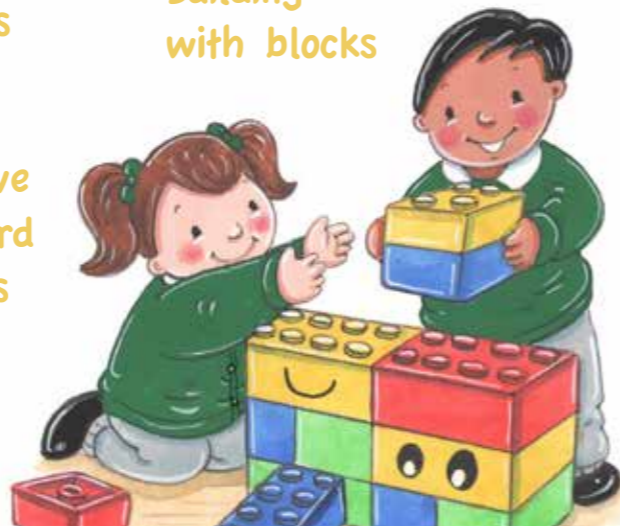
Painting and craft activities

If you feel thirsty at any other time, just ask a teacher for some water. Your teacher will be looking for good manners, especially during snack time.



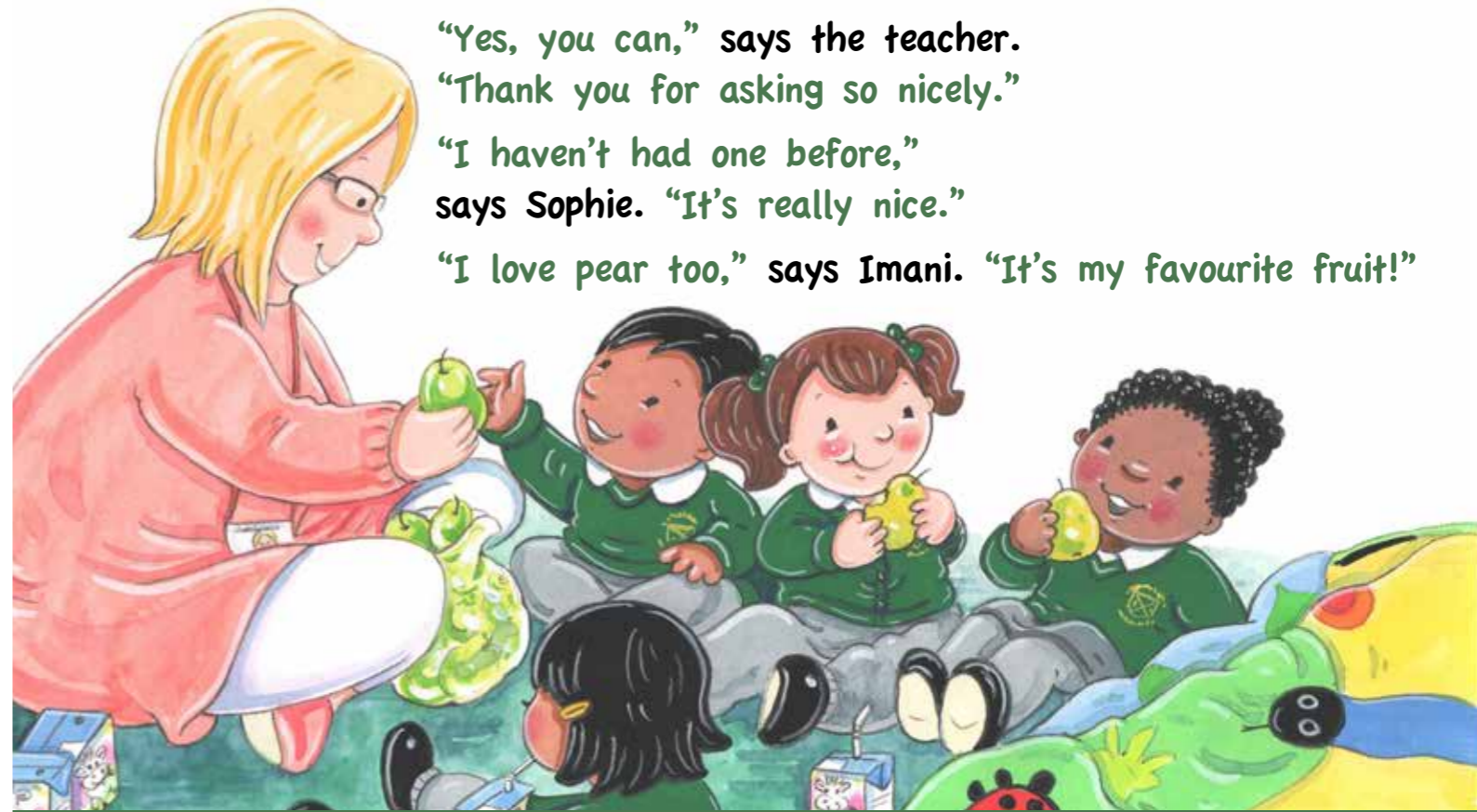
“Can I have a pear, please?” asks Dalip.

Dalip and Sophie are playing a puzzle game together.

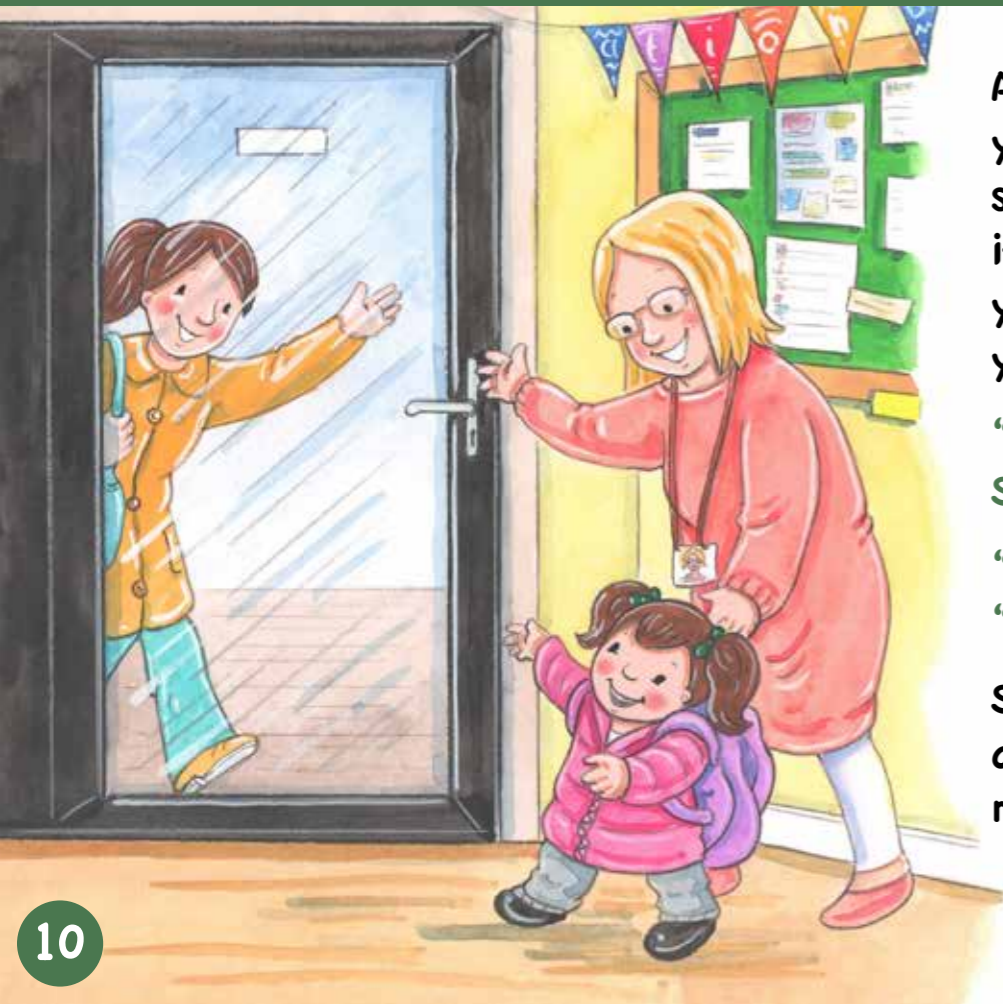
"Where does your shape fit?" asks the teacher.

You will also take home a ‘busy bag’ which will have shapes and numbers in it for you to look at and learn about.

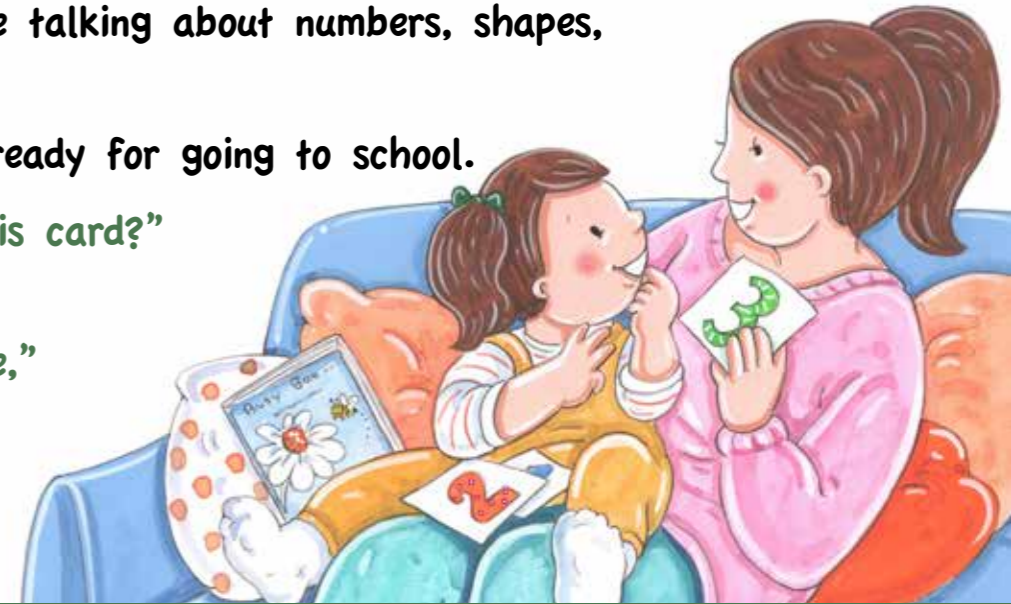
Sophie and her mum are talking about what she has done at Terrific for Twos. They are talking about numbers, shapes, colours and letters.
